Only WIRU COMMUNITY MENTAL HEALTH SERVICES and Specialist Support Coordination Services employees involved with your service, or who are providing support to those caring for you, may see your personal or sensitive information. WIRU COMMUNITY HEALTH & WELL-BEING SERVICES are required to adhere to, and sign, code of conduct and confidentiality agreement upon signing a new service agreement. The situation may arise where WIRU COMMUNITY MENTAL HEALTH SERVICES and Specialist Support Coordinators, Government and non-Government organisations must collect information from other agencies in order to provide services to you. When considering who we collect information about you from, our employees use the following principles as set out in Data Protection Act 1998:

- Only collect information from those needed in order to provide good quality service.
- Collect the minimum information necessary to ensure good quality service.
